

Materials:

- 1. 4.25mm hook
- 2. worsted weight yarn in black, purple, orange, brown, yellow
- 3. yarn needle
- 4. 18 mm yellow cat safety eyes
- 5. 15 mm pink safety animal nose
- 6. yellow button
- 7. doll stuffing

Stitches Used:

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- sc2tog = sc two stitches together, a decrease stitch
- mc = magic circle
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- ss = slip stitch

Pattern Notes:

- -You will be working in rounds so you will not join at the end of each round.
- -The cat head and body are one piece, no sewing there, yay!

2sc = crocheting two sc into one stitch sc 2= sc one stitch into each of the next two stitches

Directions:

Cat Head and Body:

With black yarn, make a magic circle

Round 1: sc 10 into mc

Round 2: 2 sc into each st around (20 sc)

Round 3: [sc, 2 sc] repeat around (30sc)

Round 4: [2sc, sc 2] repeat around (40sc)

Round 5: [sc 3, 2sc] repeat around (50sc)

Rounds 6-16: sc in each st around (50sc)

Round 17: [sc 3, sc2tog] repeat around (40sc)

Round 18: [sc 2, sc2tog] repeat around (30sc)

Attach eyes between rounds 10 and 11

Attach nose between rounds 12 and 13

Round 19: [sc, sc2tog] repeat around (20sc)

Start stuffing.

Round 20: sc around (20sc)

Round 21: sc around (20sc)

Round 22: [sc, 2sc] repeat around (30sc)

Round 23: [sc 2, 2sc] repeat around (40sc)

Round 24: sc around (40sc)

Round 25: sc around (40sc)

Round 26: [sc 3, 2 sc] repeat around (50sc)

Round 27: sc around (50sc)

Round 28: [sc 4, 2 sc] repeat around (60sc)

Rounds 29-35: sc around (60sc)

Round 36: [sc 4, sc2tog] repeat around (50sc)

Round 37: sc around (50sc)

Round 38: [sc 3, sc2tog] repeat around (40sc)

Round 39: [sc 2, sc2tog] repeat around (30sc)

Round 40: [sc, sc2tog] repeat round (20sc)

Stuff.

Round 41: sc2 tog around (10sc)

Round 42: sc2tog around (5sc)

Fasten off. Leave a long tail and sew the hole closed. Weave in the ends.

EARS:

Make 2

With black, make a magic circle

Round 1: sc 4 into mc (4sc)

Round 2: 2sc into each st around (8sc)

Round 3: sc around (8sc)

Round 4: [sc, 2sc] repeat around (12sc)

Round 5: [sc 2, 2sc] repeat around (16sc)

Round 6: [sc 3, 2sc] repeat around (20sc)

Round 7: sc around (20sc) ss to first sc of round 7

Fasten off leaving tail for sewing. Sew to the cat's head.



TAIL:

With black, make a magic circle

Round 1: sc 8 into mc (8sc)

Rounds 2-25: sc around

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing and sew onto the cat. Weave in ends.

WITCH HAT:

When you make the color change, you will be joining with ss at the end of each round. This helps the color change not be as noticeable.

With purple, make a magic circle

Round 1: sc 6 into mc (6sc)

Round 2: sc around (6sc)

Round 3: 2sc into each st around (12sc)

Round 4: sc around (12sc)

Round 5: [2sc, sc] repeat around (18sc)

Round 6: sc around (18sc)

Round 7: sc around (18sc)

Round 8: [2sc, sc 2] repeat around (24sc)

Round 9: sc around (24 sc)

Round 10: [2sc, sc 3] repeat around. Change to orange yarn in last st. ss to first st of round, ch 1 (30sc)


Round 11: 2sc into same st as join, sc 4 [2sc, sc 4] repeat around. Join. Ch 1 (36sc)

Round 12: sc into same st as join and in each st around. Change back to purple in last st. Join to first st of round. ch 1

Round 13: 2sc into each st around. join, ch 1 (72sc)

Round 14: sc around (72sc)

Fasten off and weave in ends.



COLLAR:

With purple, ch 29

Row 1: sc in 2^{nd} ch from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn (28sc)

Row 2: sc across

Fasten off, leave tail for sewing. Sew the yellow button to the front of the collar. Sew the collar onto the cat's neck.

BROOM:

With brown, make a magic circle

Round 1: sc 4 into mc (4sc)

Rounds 2-20: sc around

Fasten off weave in ends.

With yellow, cut pieces of yarn about 6 inches long. Cut as many or as few as you would like. It depends how puffy you want your broom to be. Using your yarn needle, pull the yellow strands through the bottom of the broom stick. Once you have as many as you want, take a piece of brown yarn and tie it around the yellow to make the band. Cut the yellow yarn to your desired length. Enjoy!
